

Motorized Boat Registration

Welcome! Danforth Bay aims to provide a safe, enjoyable boating experience for all our guests and neighbors. Please review the following boating rules and guidelines to ensure our success:

REGISTRATION & FEES

- All motorized boats must be registered at the office, regardless of size.
- Seasonal campers with a dock slip: Fee included in dock slip rates.
- Seasonal campers without a dock slip: \$75 per season
- Transient campers: \$50 per reservation

BOAT RULES

- One motorized boat per site; max length 21 feet.
- **State Registration** is required for most boats. Follow all NH boating laws.

PROHIBITED WATERCRAFT & ACTIVITIES

- **Jet Skis/Jet Boats**: Not allowed at the launch, docks, or shoreline. No passenger drop-offs/pickups permitted. May be stored in the outside lot with an ID tag from the office.
- **Tow Sports (e.g. tubing, waterskiing, wakeboarding)**: Not permitted from our waterfront. Use Broad Bay or Ossipee Lake instead.

DOCKS & LAUNCHING

- **Boat launch** open from 7 AM to dusk. Use caution in shallow water.
- No fishing from docks. Only slip renters and their guests allowed past the dock gate.
- Do not dock in another guest's slip.
- Moorings and overnight offshore anchoring are not allowed.

BEACHING & STORAGE

- No overnight beaching anywhere on the property.
- **Daytime beaching** only allowed for specific waterfront sites (C27, 28, 30, 32, 34, 36, H6–H8, and seasonal Sunapee).
- Loading/unloading only allowed near boat launch and in front of sites C10–C16. Be quick and courteous.

ENVIRONMENTAL CARE

- **Milfoil & Invasive Species**: Inspect and clean your boat/trailer before launch and after use. A rinse hose is available at the launch.
- Huckins Pond: No motorized boats allowed, including trolling motors.

SAFETY & COURTESY

- Keep 150 feet from shorelines, docks, boats, and swimmers unless traveling at headway speed (no wake, under 6 mph).
- Use caution and minimize noise, especially mornings and evenings.
- Never enter roped swim areas.

REQUIREMENTS

- Must carry Coast Guard-approved life jackets, throw cushion, fire extinguisher (powerboats), sound device, paddle.
- Lights required on all vessels after dark.
- No operating under the influence—legal BAC limit is 0.08. NH law strictly enforced.

OTHER INFO

- **ID Tag**: Provided at check-in; must be visible on the boat.
- **Parking**: Limited day-use ramp parking. Overnight storage allowed on-site or in the boat storage lot.
- **Boater's License**: Required for anyone 16+ operating a boat with over 25HP. Must carry proof of certification.
