

CAMPER GUIDELINES



25 THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

Danforth Bay Camping & RV Resort:

The following rules and regulations have been established so that everyone may enjoy their visit with us. Please be sure that anyone staying at your site, whether adult or child, knows and understands what is allowed. Anyone failing to abide by the following will be asked to leave or if necessary, removed by the local authorities. Parents are responsible for their children's behavior, safety, and whereabouts at all times while within the park.

The Bluffs RV Resort:

The Bluffs is an adult (50+) only seasonal section of the park for registered campers and their registered guests only. Facilities and amenities located in The Bluffs, such as pools, tennis courts, buildings, and scheduled activities are for use by The Bluffs registered campers and their adult (21+) registered guests only.

However, from dawn to dusk all campers are invited to take a walk or biking tour within The Bluffs, with anyone under the age of 21 accompanied by an adult.

1. Quiet Time: Quiet time is from 11 pm to 7 am. Children under 18 must be on their registered site by 11 pm unless accompanied by an adult. Loud, objectionable noise, amplified music, and karaoke are not allowed at any time.

2. Campfires: Campfires are allowed 7 am to 11:30 pm. Fires must be completely extinguished with water (no flames or hot coals) by 11:30 pm. Fires are only permitted in campground provided fire rings, which may not be relocated. Any type of open flamed unit fueled by propane is not allowed. Campfires **must never be left unattended**. Flames should be no higher than 24" above the rim and wood must be contained within the perimeter of the fire ring. No type of awning or covering may be placed over the fire. Only firewood may be burned; do not burn trash, bottles/cans, treated/painted wood, pallets etc. It is illegal to transport firewood across state lines. NH Dept. of Agriculture says to "Buy It Where You Burn It".

3. Occupancy: All rental locations must be reserved/occupied by an adult at least 21 years of age. At Danforth Bay, children are 18 years & younger.

- **Camp Sites:** Rates include 2 adults and 2 children. Additional guests may be registered for a fee. A maximum of 8 people, with no more than 4 of them being adults are allowed. Only 1 camping unit and 1 tent or 2 tents are allowed per campsite.
- **Cabins/Cottage:** Rates include 2 adults and 2 children. Additional guests may be registered for a fee. A maximum of 6 people, with no more than 4 being adults are allowed in camping cabins and cottage, No pets, No Smoking/Vaping allowed (a \$300 fee will be assessed in the event any of these have occurred in the cabin/cottage). Only 1 tent is allowed, and it must be placed on the gravel, not grass.
- **Bayside Studio:** Rate includes 2 adults only. Additional guests may not be registered. No pets, No Smoking/Vaping allowed (a \$300 fee will be assessed in the event any of these have occurred in the studio).

4. Visitors: All day and overnight visitors must be registered at the office upon arrival and are not allowed to bring boats, golf carts or pets. Day guests must leave the park by 8 pm. The primary occupant who reserved the site is responsible for the behavior or any damage caused by themselves, their family members, and any registered day/overnight guests.

5. Etiquette: As a family campground guests are expected to be respectful and courteous to others. Any type of bullying, aggressive behavior or actions deemed inappropriate by management, towards any guest(s) or member of the resort team, will result in removal from the park and forfeiture of the site without refund. Profanity will not be tolerated. Repeat offenders will be asked to leave the park.

6. Alcohol: New Hampshire's drinking age is 21. Underage drinking, use of drugs, excessive use of alcohol, or any other illegal activities will result in immediate removal by local authorities. Intoxicated, loud and/or obnoxious behaviors are not permitted. NEVER leave alcohol where it is accessible to others. No type of outside bar, such as a tiki bar, is allowed.

7. Smoking/Vaping: Is not permitted inside or within 25 feet of buildings, the pool, or beach, and is prohibited by anyone under the age of 21. Repeat offenders will be asked to leave.

8. Privacy: Please do not cut through other campers' sites on foot, on a bicycle, with a golf cart or any other means.

9. Drones: Drones are not allowed on property.

10. Pyrotechnic Devices: Firecrackers, sparklers, or any other pyrotechnic devices are not permitted.

11. Utilities: Campers staying in any type of camping RV with holding tanks, **must keep valves closed at all times**, except when dumping, and **must** add waste digester to the start of every new tank. It is illegal to dump gray water on the ground. Dispose of gray and black water through the sewer hookup on your site or at the nearest dump station. The campground cannot guarantee that utilities, such as electricity or water, will not be uninterrupted, as a result of weather/temperatures, or any unforeseen circumstances. Tampering with the utilities is prohibited.

12. Backflow preventers: Backflow preventers have been added to water spigots. A \$100 fine will be assessed to anyone found to have removed the backflow preventer, which is not a pressure reducer.

13. Trash: Bagged household trash only may be disposed of promptly in trash dumpsters located throughout the park. To deter wildlife in the park, never leave trash sitting outside your camping unit.

14. Wildlife: Wildlife and insects are a natural part of the camping experience. Make sure to put food away in sealed containers. Never feed or harass the wildlife.

15. Trees & Shrubs: Cutting of trees, saplings, and shrubs are strictly prohibited.

16. Playgrounds: Playgrounds are located in Danforth Bay only. Hours are from 8:30 am until sunset. Children should not be left unattended.

17. Children's Toys: For the safety of our campers, battery and motor powered toys of any type are not allowed including self-balancing, hover boards, one wheel boards, and razors. The use of paintball guns is prohibited within the park.

18. Bike Riding: Bike riding after dark is not permitted. NH Law requires helmet use for children under the age of 16, but we strongly encourage helmet use by everyone. Park bicycles in bike racks. Do not block doorways or walkways to buildings. Bike tags will be given at check in and must be displayed on bike throughout reservation. Bicyclists must obey all traffic signs and ride responsibly. Management reserves the right to remove a bicycle from any guest who jeopardizes the safety of themselves and/or others.

19. Motorized Boats:

- All boat operators should know the NH Boating Laws and Responsibilities: **www.boat-ed.com/newhampshire/handbook/**
- All boat owners must read and follow the guidelines on the Motorized Boat Registration Form. ***Due to milfoil concerns powerboats of any type, including small boats with trolling motors, are not allowed in Huckins Pond.***
- Only one boat per site is allowed and must be registered with the office at check-in (\$).
- Motorboats larger than 21' are not permitted.
- Jet-powered watercraft of any type are not in Danforth Bay Camping & RV Resort. Jet-powered watercraft traveling from Broad Bay and into Danforth Bay, are not allowed to drop off/pick up passengers from our shoreline, to beach, or be on the docks.
- Waterskiing, tubing, wakeboarding or any towable watersport is not allowed to or from our waterfront.
- Motorized boats may beach next to the boat launch area for the temporary purpose of loading and unloading, and must never be left for any length of time. Beaching for any other purpose is not allowed.
- Boat launch facility is open from 7am until dusk.
- Use caution in the boat launch area, as the water can be quite shallow.
- Parking for the day is located next to the Cove Beach Restroom. Overnight parking is located in the lot behind.
- Park your boat and trailer in designated day boat parking lots only, or on your site.
- All boat storage is at your own risk.
- You may choose to store your boat on your site and count the boat as one of your two approved vehicles on site.
- Transportation of milfoil, zebra mussels, and other non-native or invasive species are of special concern. A hose is provided at the boat launch area for washing down your boat before and after launching.
- Moorings are not permitted. No boat may be anchored offshore overnight.

20. Boat Slips: No fishing from or swimming around the boat slips/dock. Boat slips are rented on a seasonal basis. Only boat owners and their guest(s) are allowed beyond the gate.

21. Speed Limit: The speed limit in the park is 7 mph for all vehicles including golf carts and bicycles, unless otherwise posted. Use caution over speed bumps throughout the park.

22. Motorized Vehicles: Only 2 vehicles are permitted per site, and may not park on the side of the road or in the wood line. Additional vehicles may be registered for \$5/day or \$25/ week and will be required to park in overflow parking. Motorized vehicles allowed are trucks, cars, motorcycles, and golf carts. They must be registered with the office at check in and must **always display a car pass on the rearview mirror**. No means of transportation may be operated at night without power lighting. See management for the approval of alternate means of transportation for handicap use.

- *Scooters, Mopeds & GEM cars must be registered for use on the road and recorded with the office as one of your two allowed vehicles. ATV's, UTV's, golf carts designed for off road use, dirt bikes, Segways, or similar means of transportation are NOT permitted to be driven or ridden inside the park. Management reserves the right to determine if something does not meet the campgrounds criteria.*

23. Golf Carts: Only 1 golf cart will be permitted per site. Golf carts designed for use on grass/turf only (**golf carts designed for off road use, other cart variations, ATV's, UTV's, etc. are NOT allowed**). Golf carts must be registered with the campground at check in and must have an operating headlight and taillight, **and a valid certificate of insurance** before being permitted to operate. Golf cart use is only allowed on campground property and must not be taken off road on wooded trails or be driven on town roads, to include Shawtown Road. All drivers must provide **a valid driver's license** (age restrictions apply), read and follow all guidelines on the golf cart registration form, and register with the office. Management reserves the right to ban the use of any golf cart by any camper failing to abide by these rules. Guests may rent carts from outside sources, but the cart must be brought in and removed from the park by the registered guest(s).

- ***Privately owned golf cart operators are restricted to licensed drivers 19 and older.***
- ***Rental golf carts are restricted to 2 licensed drivers 21 and older.***
- ***Only Bluffs seasonal campers and their registered guests, who are 21 and older, may operate a golf cart in the Bluffs.***

24. Beach & Pool Rules:

- ***There are no lifeguards on duty at any time. Swimming is at your own risk.***
- Swimming at beach areas is not allowed after dark.
- Pets are not allowed in pool areas or on the beaches. Pets may swim at the canoe launch area located ***beyond*** Cove Beach.
- Diving is not permitted into ***any*** pool.
- Smoking/Vaping is not permitted within 25 ft. of any pool.
- An adult must always accompany children under the age of 14 while at the beach or in the Depot pool area.
- No glass allowed in pool area.
- Swim diapers are required for children who are not toilet trained.
- Horseplay/roughhousing such as pushing, shoving, etc. on the swim raft or in the pool area(s) are not allowed.
- Boat, canoes & kayaks are not allowed within the designated swim areas.
- Do not leave personal belongings, floats, towels, chairs, etc. at the beach or pool unattended. Reserving of tables and chairs at the pool is not allowed if you are not present.
- Beaches and pools are closed during severe weather for your safety.

Water Feature Slide Rules:

- No running or roughhousing – please play gently.
- Slide feet first, on the kiddie slide in a sitting position.
- Wait for the landing area to clear before sliding.
- The kiddie slides are for kids 8 and under only – Adults may accompany kids.
- Access to slides is from the stairs only; do not climb up the slides.
- Do not hang on, roughhouse or tamper with pool features.

25. Pet Policy:

To ensure everyone enjoys their stay, including our furry family members, please adhere to the following pet guidelines.

- Danforth Bay welcomes family pets that are well socialized, friendly, and happy.
- Pets displaying any aggressive, disruptive behavior or constant barking must be removed immediately.
- Pet(s) **may not be left unattended in your RV**, on your site, or in any vehicle, as to disturb others while you are away.
- Pets are **NOT ALLOWED** in **CABINS, COTTAGES, THE STUDIO, BEACHES OR POOL** areas or any campground BUILDING/FACILITIES.
- **VISITORS** of registered campers are **NOT ALLOWED TO BRING PETS** into the campground.
- Only 2 dogs per site are allowed.
- Pets **must** be on a leash **at all times**; no type of containment system such as fencing or kennels are allowed.
- Pets must be registered with the front office and a copy of a current rabies certificate must be provided for pets upon request.
- It is your responsibility to pick up after them. Pet waste bag stations are located throughout the park.
- Swimming for your pet is allowed at the entrance to the channel located just **beyond** Cove Beach (where canoe/kayak storage is located).
- The Pet Park is open dawn to dusk; see rules posted. Dog handlers must be 18 or older.
- Resort is not responsible, and will hold accountable the pet owner for any injury or damage caused by pet(s). Owner is expected to resolve any issue with the injured party.

Stop by the check-in windows anytime during your stay to get a treat for your furry family member!

Danforth Bay Camping & RV Resort is not responsible for any theft, loss by fire or accident. Any personal property including, but not limited to, canoes & kayaks, whether on your site or within the park, are stored at your own risk. Use of any of the facilities is strictly at your own risk. Parents will be held responsible and pay for any damages to property, facilities etc. caused by themselves, their children and any guests. Regardless of type of accommodations, all campers, their children, and guests/visitors assume all risks and danger incidental to their stay as well as damage to personal property including specifically (but not limited to), the danger of being injured by insects or animals, of being injured while participating in recreational activities, and/or being injured as a result of inclement weather conditions, and agrees that Danforth Bay Camping & RV Resort and its owners, agents and employees are not liable for injuries or property damage resulting from such risks and danger. Additional rules and guidelines apply to winter camping season.

Rentals are available during the spring and fall (non holidays) for \$60/day and during the summer for \$75/day or \$400/week. We now offer 6 passenger golf carts as well for \$100/day during the spring and fall (non holidays) and \$125/day or \$700/week during the summer. A damage deposit of \$1000 will be taken in the event of any damage.

****All guests bringing a motorized boat to the park must read the motorized boat information and register it with the office.****

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE



WATER

- Danforth Bay has excellent water pressure. We highly recommend the use of pressure reducers (available for purchase in the Depot).
- Site water availability in the late fall and early spring is weather dependent.
- In the event you experience a significant reduction in water pressure, be sure to remove any pressure reducers or in-line filters to examine them for dirt or sand.



ELECTRICITY

If you experience the loss of power at your site, be sure to check the following before reporting the problem to the office. Please note, the breaker should be shut off at the pedestal before plugging in or unplugging your camping unit.

- Check to be sure the electrical breakers are on in the site's electrical panel and that your power cord is securely plugged in.
- Check to be sure the ground fault (GFCI) outlet has not tripped at the site's electrical panel. There are two buttons located on a 110-power outlet; one is a test, and one is a reset.
- Check that the breaker or GFCI outlet has not tripped in your camping unit.



SEPTIC

Septic hookups are located on many sites. Please be sure to use environmentally, and septic system friendly, holding tank additives only.

To avoid unpleasant odors or potential septic backup:

- Be sure you have a good, tight-fitting seal when attaching to our septic connections.
- You must keep your holding tank valves closed. Only open to empty your holding tanks when they indicate at least three-quarters full or just before you check out.
- It is **illegal** in the state of New Hampshire to dump gray water on the ground. Please dispose of your gray water appropriately through your sewer hookup at your site or the nearest dump station.

TROUBLESHOOTING GUIDE



WIFI TROUBLESHOOTER

- Make sure Wi-Fi is enabled on your device. The steps for how to do this vary depending on the device; please refer to your owner's manual for future details.
- Move a few feet away from your RV. Metals used to construct the RV and/or electronic devices within the unit can cause interference.
- Other factors to consider are your distance from an access point, the current weather, and physical obstructions including other RV's, buildings, trees, and hills.
- Wi-Fi connections are named **Welcome to Danforth Bay** and/or **Welcome to The Bluffs**. All access points are unsecure and do not require a password.
- There are wired connections in the Depot and The Bluffs Clubhouse.
- Still having a problem? Reach out to our Office via text, phone or email and someone from our staff will be in touch (may take up to 24 hours).
